

**POLLING PLACE BUFFER ZONES FOR
ALLEGHANY COUNTY
November 8, 2022**

The following is a list of Alleghany County polling places and description of each buffer zone concerning Election Day electioneering. Buffer zones, as designated by G.S. 163-166.4(a)m county board of elections shall, where practical, set the limit at 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event shall it set the limit at more than 50 feet or less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with Caution tape or Signs.
Alleghany Administrative Building-Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from rear entrance door.

Cherry Lane: Cherry Lane Fire Department – Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from main door.

Gap Civil: Sparta United Methodist Church Pugh Outreach Center – Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from side door to the Pugh Outreach Center.

Glade Creek: Glade Creek Fire Department – Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from main door.

Prathers Creek: Mount Zion United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall – Electioneering is allowed 50 feet from side door.
